# Security Analysis Report: Japan (May 25, 2026 - June 01, 2026)

## Executive Summary

During the period of May 25 to June 01, 2026, Japan significantly advanced its security posture through a series of legislative, diplomatic, and defense initiatives. A key development was the parliamentary enactment of a bill to establish a National Intelligence Council and Agency, centralizing intelligence gathering and analysis to counter evolving threats. Concurrently, Japan deepened its defense cooperation with regional allies, notably the Philippines, through high-level diplomatic visits and discussions on defense equipment transfers, including missiles and warships. Cybersecurity remained a critical focus, with the government establishing a task force to address AI-related vulnerabilities and preparing for anticipated cyberattacks. These actions underscore Japan's proactive approach to a complex security environment, marked by increasing regional tensions and the imperative to bolster both its domestic defense capabilities and international partnerships.

## Key Security Developments

- Intelligence Centralization and Reform

Japan's parliament enacted a bill on May 27, 2026, to establish a National Intelligence Council and a National Intelligence Agency, aimed at strengthening the government's intelligence capabilities. This move centralizes intelligence activities, which were previously fragmented across various ministries like the police, foreign ministry, and defense ministry, under the direct review of the Prime Minister's office. The new council, chaired by the prime minister, will investigate and discuss critical intelligence activities related to national security, terrorism, and foreign influence operations, with the agency expected to launch as early as July. This reform is a direct response to criticisms that Japan's existing policies against espionage were too relaxed, with the goal of enhancing the ability to detect and block organized attacks.

- Enhanced Defense Cooperation with the Philippines

Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. visited Tokyo from May 26 to 29, 2026, where he and Japanese Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi agreed to elevate their bilateral

relations to a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership. Discussions focused heavily on maritime security and defense cooperation, with a commitment to ensuring open, secure, and rules-governed seas. On May 31, Defense Minister Shinjiro Koizumi and his Philippine counterpart, Gilberto Teodoro, affirmed talks on the export of Type-88 surface-to-ship missiles from Japan to the Philippines, following their use in the Balikatan exercises. They also broadly agreed on the transfer of Abukuma-class destroyers to the Philippines upon their decommissioning.

- Cybersecurity Task Force and AI Threat Mitigation

The Japanese government announced the formation of a specialized task force to address cybersecurity threats related to artificial intelligence on April 24, 2026, with Finance Minister Satsuki Katayama highlighting concerns about AI models exploiting security vulnerabilities. This follows reports that an AI model, "Mythos," uncovered thousands of security vulnerabilities, prompting warnings from cybersecurity experts about accelerated cyberattacks, especially in the banking sector. Japanese banks are increasing cybersecurity budgets and deploying advanced defense systems in anticipation of "Mythos"-linked attacks expected to intensify in the fall of 2026.

- Strengthening Critical Infrastructure Cyber Defense

On May 19, 2026, Japan compiled a package of measures to enhance cyber defense systems for critical infrastructure operators across 15 industry sectors, including telecommunications, finance, and medicine. Cybersecurity Minister Hisashi Matsumoto stated the government's aim to build the "world's highest" cyber resilience. The package involves gathering and analyzing cyber defense information, promoting expert development, and fostering international cooperation with governments and AI development companies.

- Defense Minister's Engagements at Shangri-La Dialogue

Japanese Defense Minister Shinjiro Koizumi attended the Asia Security Summit (Shangri-La Dialogue) in Singapore, concluding on June 1, 2026. During his address, Koizumi subtly rebutted China's criticism of Japan pursuing "new militarism" by highlighting Japan's lack of nuclear weapons and strategic bombers. He also held discussions with U.S. Secretary of Defense Pete Hegseth on May 30, where they concurred on accelerating security cooperation to strengthen the Japan-U.S. Alliance's deterrence and response capabilities, including co-development and co-production of missiles.

- Multinational Military Exercises

Japan is participating in several multinational military exercises. Exercise Southern Jackaroo 2026 commenced on May 29, 2026, in Townsville, Australia, bringing together U.S. Marines, Sailors, Soldiers, the Australian Defence Force, and Japan Self-Defense Force for a month-long training event focused on combined arms integration and tactical interoperability. Additionally, Japan and the U.S. will hold

Resolute Dragon 26 (June 20-30) and the Japan segment of Valiant Shield 2026 (June 22-July 1) in Japan, involving the Japan Ground Self-Defense Force and the U.S. Marine Corps. The Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force's "Indo-Pacific Deployment 2026 (IPD26)" unit will also conduct a bilateral exercise with the U.S. Marine Corps in the Western Pacific from June 4-12, focusing on deck landing and take-off training with F-35Bs.

- Defense Policy and Export Rule Revisions

Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi finalized a significant overhaul of Japan's decades-old military export regulations on April 21, 2026, effectively eliminating restrictions on sales of lethal weapons to closest security partners. This historic shift aims to build Japan's defense manufacturing and technological base and strengthen cooperation with like-minded countries. The government is also undertaking another overhaul of Japan's three key security documents, expected by the end of 2026, in response to China's growing threat and the changing nature of warfare.

- Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA) Expansion

Japan is advancing the "integration of maritime information systems" to share vessel data with eight Southeast Asian countries by the first half of the 2030s, utilizing Official Development Assistance (ODA) and Official Security Assistance (OSA) programs. This Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA) system detects and analyzes real-time movements of vessels via satellites, radar, ship signals, drones, and patrol aircraft, aiming to secure vital sea lanes like the Taiwan Strait and the Strait of Malacca.

- Counter-Terrorism Consultations

The International Conference on Counter Terrorism and Human Security (ICCTHS) was held in Tokyo, Japan, on May 25-26, 2026. Furthermore, the Fourth Round of Pakistan-Japan Counter-Terrorism Consultations took place on May 21, 2026, where both sides assessed evolving terrorist threats and reiterated their resolve to combat terrorism.

- Defense Industry Global Expansion

Japan's defense industry is positioning for global contracts, particularly in naval systems, aerospace components, and missile technology, following the relaxation of export restrictions. Companies like Mitsubishi Heavy Industries are exploring international partnerships, and Japan is jointly developing a next-generation fighter jet with the United Kingdom and Italy. The first Japan-EU defense industry dialogue is also planned to strengthen industry foundations and supply chain resilience.

## Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Japan's security developments during this period significantly reinforce its role as a key player in Indo-Pacific stability. The deepening alliance with the United States and the elevation of relations with the Philippines to a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership are direct responses to China's increasing assertiveness in the East and South China Seas. By agreeing to discuss the export of Type-88 surface-to-ship missiles and Abukuma-class destroyers to the Philippines, Japan is actively contributing to the deterrence capabilities of a nation at the forefront of territorial disputes with China. This move, coupled with Japan's participation in multilateral exercises like Southern Jackaroo and the upcoming Resolute Dragon and Valiant Shield, demonstrates a clear strategy of collective security and burden-sharing with allies to counter regional challenges.

The overhaul of Japan's defense export rules, allowing the transfer of lethal weapons, marks a historic departure from its post-WWII pacifist stance and signals Tokyo's intent to project power and contribute more actively to regional security. This shift is viewed by some as catering to U.S. interests in Asia and escalating tensions, particularly with China. However, Japan frames it as essential for strengthening its own defense industrial base and fostering cooperation with like-minded countries. The ongoing revision of Japan's three key security documents further underscores this strategic reorientation, driven by the perceived growing Chinese threat and the evolving nature of warfare.

The establishment of a centralized National Intelligence Council and Agency is a crucial step in Japan's effort to become a "counterintelligence state" capable of collecting, protecting, and sharing information in real-time with allies. This move aligns Japan's security framework with Western standards and aims to enhance its ability to detect and block organized cyberattacks, many of which are suspected to be linked to China and Russia. The focus on cybersecurity, particularly against AI-related threats, reflects a broader regional concern about digital vulnerabilities and the potential for state-sponsored cyber warfare. The Middle East tensions are also impacting Japan's economy, leading to reduced capital spending by companies and concerns about energy and commodity supply disruptions, which adds another layer of complexity to its geopolitical considerations.

## Military and Defense Analysis

Japan's military and defense posture is undergoing a significant transformation, moving beyond a strictly defensive stance to one that emphasizes proactive deterrence and enhanced interoperability with allies. The recent revision of defense export rules is a cornerstone of this shift, enabling Japan to export lethal weapons and engage in joint development projects, such as the next-generation fighter jet with the UK and Italy. This not only bolsters the capabilities of partner nations but also

strengthens Japan's domestic defense industrial base, which has historically experienced sluggish growth.

Defense spending continues its upward trend, with the FY2026 budget reaching approximately \$58 billion (¥9.04 trillion), an increase of about 3.8% from the previous year, nearing 2% of GDP. This funding prioritizes critical areas such as stand-off defense capabilities, integrated air and missile defense, unmanned defense systems, cross-domain operations, and command, control, communications, computers, intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (C4ISR). The acquisition and deployment of unmanned aerial, surface, and underwater systems, along with enhanced missile defense assets, are central to Japan's modernization programs. The U.S. has "high expectations" for Japan to further increase its defense spending, with some U.S. officials suggesting a target of 3.5% of GDP.

Force posture is increasingly focused on the southwestern region and the Indo-Pacific, as evidenced by the temporary deployment of U.S. military assets, including missile systems, and increased flexible air dispersal and advance bilateral presence in this area. Japan's participation in exercises like Balikatan, Southern Jackaroo, Resolute Dragon, and Valiant Shield, often involving combat troops, signifies a greater emphasis on realistic, advanced bilateral and multilateral training to improve tactical capabilities and interoperability with the U.S., Australia, and the Philippines. The plan to increase cyber personnel in the Self-Defense Forces to 20,000 by 2027, alongside the launch of a joint operations command for information warfare, highlights the growing importance of cyber capabilities in Japan's defense strategy.

## Outlook and Forecast

Short-term trends (1-3 months): In the immediate future, Japan will likely continue to solidify its enhanced intelligence capabilities with the operationalization of the National Intelligence Council and Agency as early as July. This will lead to a more integrated approach to national security intelligence. Defense cooperation with the Philippines is expected to progress rapidly, with concrete discussions and potential agreements on the export of Type-88 missiles and Abukuma-class destroyers. Joint military exercises, including Resolute Dragon 26 and the Japan segment of Valiant Shield 2026 with the U.S. in late June, and the ongoing Southern Jackaroo 2026 and IPD26 exercises, will further enhance interoperability and demonstrate allied resolve in the Indo-Pacific. Japan will also remain highly vigilant regarding cybersecurity, particularly in the financial sector, as it prepares for anticipated "Mythos"-linked cyberattacks.

Critical flashpoints and risk areas: The East China Sea and South China Sea remain critical flashpoints, with China's increasing maritime activities and territorial claims

posing a direct challenge to Japan and its allies. Any escalation in these areas, particularly around the Senkaku Islands or in the context of a potential Taiwan contingency, could rapidly draw Japan into conflict. The growing sophistication of cyber threats, especially those leveraging AI, presents a persistent and evolving risk to Japan's critical infrastructure and financial systems. Geopolitical instability in the Middle East continues to pose an economic risk to Japan, impacting energy and commodity supply chains and potentially hindering its economic recovery. North Korea's ongoing nuclear and missile development, and its potential transfer of technologies to Russia, also remain a significant security concern.

Indicators to monitor: Key indicators to monitor include the progress of defense equipment transfers to the Philippines and other Southeast Asian nations, which will signal the pace of Japan's regional security contributions. The frequency and scale of Chinese military and coast guard activities in disputed waters, particularly around the Senkaku Islands, will be crucial. Developments in Japan's cybersecurity resilience, including the effectiveness of its new AI-focused task force and critical infrastructure defenses, should be closely watched. Furthermore, the content of the revised three security documents, expected by year-end, will provide further insight into Japan's long-term strategic direction and defense spending commitments. The impact of global energy prices and supply chain stability on Japan's economy, particularly in light of Middle East tensions, will also be an important indicator of broader national resilience.

Strategic recommendations: Japan should continue to diversify and deepen its security partnerships beyond the U.S., particularly with ASEAN nations, Australia, and European partners, to create a robust network of deterrence. Investing in offensive cyber capabilities alongside defensive measures is crucial to deter and respond to sophisticated state-sponsored cyberattacks. Accelerating the modernization of its Self-Defense Forces with advanced technologies, including unmanned systems and long-range strike capabilities, remains paramount. Diplomatically, Japan should maintain clear and consistent messaging regarding international law and freedom of navigation in the Indo-Pacific, while also seeking channels for de-escalation with China. Domestically, ongoing efforts to strengthen economic security and build resilience against external shocks, such as energy supply disruptions, are essential to underpin its overall security posture.
