## Executive Summary

The period from May 01 to May 08, 2026, for Cambodia was marked by significant diplomatic efforts to de-escalate tensions with Thailand, alongside ongoing military cooperation and intensified domestic security crackdowns. Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet engaged in crucial talks with his Thai counterpart at the ASEAN Summit in Cebu, Philippines, aiming to normalize relations following deadly border clashes in 2025 and a new maritime dispute. Concurrently, Cambodia hosted the second iteration of the India-Cambodia Bilateral Military Exercise (CINBAX-II), focusing on counter-terrorism and UN peacekeeping operations. Domestically, the government continued its aggressive campaign against online scam operations, bolstered by new anti-cyber fraud legislation and the deployment of inter-agency task forces. These developments highlight Cambodia's dual focus on managing regional disputes through diplomacy while strengthening its internal security and defense capabilities.

## Key Security Developments

- Diplomatic De-escalation with Thailand

On May 7, 2026, Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet met with Thai Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul on the sidelines of the 48th ASEAN Summit in Cebu, Philippines, facilitated by Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos Jr.. The leaders agreed to rebuild trust, normalize relations, and pursue peace after deadly border clashes in 2025 that resulted in approximately 150 deaths and 300,000 displacements. This meeting is significant as it represents the first major diplomatic engagement between the two countries in months, aiming to prevent further military flare-ups.

- Resumption of Bilateral Mechanisms with Thailand

Following the high-level talks in Cebu, both Cambodia and Thailand agreed to resume bilateral mechanisms, including the Joint Border Commission, General Border Committee, and Regional Border Committee. This commitment is crucial for restoring diplomatic channels and preventing new patrol or checkpoint incidents along the disputed border, which has seen troops remain deployed. The agreement signals a practical step towards de-escalation and structured dialogue to address long-standing issues.

- Extension of ASEAN Observer Team Mandate

The mandate of the ASEAN Observer Team (AOT) was extended for another three months, until July 2026, with the Philippines coordinating its efforts. The AOT plays a

vital role in monitoring agreements and supporting stability along the disputed Thailand-Cambodia border, providing an impartial mechanism to verify ceasefire implementation and agreed measures.

- Thailand's Termination of 2001 Maritime MOU

On May 5, 2026, Thailand's cabinet approved the termination of the 2001 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Cambodia, which governed overlapping continental shelf claims and joint offshore energy exploration. Thailand cited a lack of significant progress over 25 years as the reason for its decision. This move has escalated the maritime dispute, creating uncertainty and instability in the Gulf of Thailand.

- Cambodia to Seek UNCLOS Conciliation for Maritime Dispute

In response to Thailand's unilateral termination of the 2001 MOU, Cambodia announced on May 5, 2026, its intention to initiate the compulsory conciliation mechanism under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS). Cambodian Foreign Minister Prak Sokhonn stated that Cambodia had no option but to pursue this international legal avenue, reaffirming its commitment to resolving maritime disputes peacefully and in accordance with international law.

- India-Cambodia Bilateral Military Exercise CINBAX-II 2026 Commences

The second edition of the India-Cambodia Bilateral Military Exercise, CINBAX-II 2026, began on May 4, 2026, at the Techo Sen Phnom Thom Mreas Prov Royal Cambodian Air Force Training Centre (Camp Basil) in Kampong Speu Province, Cambodia. Scheduled until May 17, 2026, the exercise involves 120 personnel from the Indian Army and 160 from the Royal Cambodian Army, focusing on company-level joint training in a sub-conventional environment. This exercise aims to enhance interoperability, coordination, and operational synergy in counter-terrorism drills and UN peacekeeping-related tasks, including drone operations, mortar drills, and sniper tactics.

- Intensified Crackdown on Online Scam Operations

Cambodia continued its aggressive crackdown on online scam operations, with special inter-agency task forces established in April 2026 to target these activities across key provinces such as Svay Rieng, Preah Sihanouk, Battambang, and Banteay Meanchey. This follows the government's pledge to shut down all online scam centers by the end of April 2026. Authorities are inspecting suspected locations, monitoring service disconnections, and requiring casino owners to prohibit scam operations on their premises.

- New Anti-Technology Fraud Law Enacted

The Law on Anti-Technology Fraud was unanimously approved by Cambodia's Senate on April 3, 2026, and by the National Assembly days earlier, marking the country's

first dedicated legislation against cyber fraud. This law introduces severe penalties, including prison sentences ranging from 15 to 30 years, or even life imprisonment for ringleaders if their activities result in death. The legislation targets "pig butchering" scams, human trafficking for forced labor, and cryptocurrency-based money laundering, aiming to dismantle criminal networks and restore Cambodia's international reputation.

- China-Cambodia "2+2" Strategic Dialogue Outcomes

While occurring just before the reporting period (April 22, 2026), the first meeting of the China-Cambodia "2+2" strategic dialogue mechanism between foreign and defense ministers in Phnom Penh has significant implications for Cambodia's security posture. Both nations agreed to deepen law enforcement and defense cooperation, jointly combat online gambling and telecom fraud, and safeguard cybersecurity. This institutional upgrade underscores a deepened commitment to coordinated strategic positions and mutual assistance.

- Upcoming Military Conscription Implementation

Prime Minister Hun Manet reaffirmed in July 2025 that Cambodia's long-dormant military conscription law, approved in 2006, would be implemented starting in 2026. The mandatory service period will be extended from 18 to 24 months, with the stated aim of increasing troop numbers and upgrading military capabilities, partly in response to rising tensions with Thailand. This represents a significant shift in defense policy.

## Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Cambodia's security developments during this period have notable implications for regional stability, particularly within ASEAN. The high-level meeting between Cambodian and Thai leaders at the ASEAN Summit, facilitated by the Philippines, underscores the bloc's commitment to internal crisis management and peaceful dispute resolution. While the agreement to de-escalate and resume dialogue mechanisms is a positive step, the underlying land border dispute remains unresolved, and the emergence of a new offshore energy dispute following Thailand's termination of the 2001 MOU adds a fresh layer of complexity. Cambodia's decision to seek UNCLOS conciliation for the maritime claims signals a reliance on international law, which could set a precedent for other regional maritime disputes.

Relations with major powers continue to be shaped by Cambodia's "hedging" strategy. The ongoing CINBAX-II military exercise with India highlights Cambodia's efforts to diversify its defense partnerships beyond its traditionally strong ties with China. This engagement with India, focusing on counter-terrorism and UN peacekeeping, contributes to a more balanced regional security architecture. Simultaneously, the

recent "2+2" strategic dialogue with China in April 2026 reinforces Beijing's significant influence, with agreements to deepen defense and law enforcement cooperation. China's support for Cambodia in combating online scams and safeguarding cybersecurity also strengthens this bilateral bond. The survey showing high optimism for China-Cambodia relations due to Belt and Road Initiative projects further solidifies China's economic and political footprint.

The persistent issue of online scam operations, with Cambodia as a major hub, continues to draw international scrutiny, impacting its reputation and potentially its economic stability. The aggressive crackdown and new anti-cyber fraud law are crucial steps for Cambodia to address these concerns and avoid being placed on international financial watchlists. The involvement of foreign nationals in these scams and the cooperation with countries like China and the US in combating them demonstrate the transnational nature of this threat and the need for broader international collaboration.

## Military and Defense Analysis

Cambodia's military posture during this period reflects a combination of modernization efforts, enhanced training, and a strategic response to perceived threats. The commencement of the CINBAX-II 2026 exercise with India is a significant development, showcasing the Royal Cambodian Army's commitment to improving its capabilities in sub-conventional warfare, counter-terrorism, and UN peacekeeping operations. The focus on drone operations, mortar drills, and sniper tactics indicates an emphasis on modern combat skills relevant to contemporary security challenges. This bilateral exercise also contributes to interoperability, which is vital for potential multinational deployments.

A major shift in defense policy is the impending implementation of military conscription starting in 2026, with the service period extended to 24 months. This move, announced in July 2025 and reaffirmed by Prime Minister Hun Manet, is explicitly linked to increasing troop numbers and upgrading military capabilities, partly in response to persistent border tensions with Thailand. This suggests a strategic decision to bolster the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces' (RCAF) personnel strength and readiness. The government's pledge to "look at increasing" the defense budget further supports this modernization drive.

While specific defense acquisitions within the May 1-8, 2026, period were not reported, Cambodia's defense industry continues to benefit from its close ties with China. Past acquisitions of Multiple Launch Rocket Systems (MLRS) from China's Norinco and the construction of a naval facility for military vessels on the coast of Cambodia (as reported in March 2026) highlight China's role in Cambodia's military

modernization. The "2+2" strategic dialogue with China in April 2026 also included agreements to strengthen defense cooperation and assist Cambodia in accelerating its defense capacity building. The modernized Ream Naval Base, which welcomes friendly foreign vessels for joint exercises and counter-terrorism cooperation, underscores Cambodia's growing maritime capabilities and its role in regional maritime security.

## Outlook and Forecast

**Short-term trends (1-3 months):** In the immediate future, Cambodia will likely focus on navigating the complexities of its renewed diplomatic engagement with Thailand. The foreign ministers of both nations are tasked with continuing detailed discussions, and the effectiveness of these talks will be a critical indicator. The India-Cambodia CINBAX-II exercise will conclude, and its outcomes, particularly regarding enhanced interoperability and shared best practices, will be assessed. Domestically, the crackdown on online scam operations is expected to continue, with authorities aiming to fully dismantle remaining scam centers and enforce the new anti-technology fraud law. The implementation of military conscription in 2026 will begin to take shape, potentially leading to public awareness campaigns and initial recruitment drives.

**Critical flashpoints and risk areas:** The primary flashpoint remains the Thailand-Cambodia border, both land and maritime. Despite de-escalation talks, the unresolved land border dispute and the new offshore energy dispute, exacerbated by Thailand's termination of the 2001 MOU, pose significant risks. Any new patrol or checkpoint incidents, or aggressive posturing related to maritime claims, could quickly reignite tensions. The process of compulsory conciliation under UNCLOS, initiated by Cambodia, could be protracted and contentious. Another risk area is the effectiveness of the anti-scam crackdown. If criminal networks prove resilient or if enforcement is perceived as insufficient, Cambodia's international reputation could suffer further, potentially leading to economic repercussions or renewed pressure from international bodies like the FATF.

**Indicators to monitor:** Key indicators to monitor include the progress of diplomatic talks between Cambodia and Thailand, particularly the resumption and effectiveness of the Joint Border Commission and other bilateral mechanisms. Any reports of military movements or incidents along the border or in the Gulf of Thailand should be closely watched. On the domestic front, the number of successful raids, arrests, and repatriations related to online scams, as well as the enforcement of penalties under the new cyber fraud law, will indicate the success of the crackdown. Furthermore, statements from the National Bank of Cambodia regarding efforts to combat money laundering and avoid FATF grey-listing will be important.

Strategic recommendations: Cambodia should prioritize sustained, high-level diplomatic engagement with Thailand to resolve both land and maritime disputes through peaceful means, leveraging ASEAN's mediation efforts. Actively pursuing the UNCLOS conciliation mechanism with clear legal arguments is essential for the maritime dispute. Internally, Cambodia must ensure the comprehensive and transparent implementation of the anti-technology fraud law, demonstrating tangible results in dismantling scam networks and prosecuting perpetrators, including those with high-level connections. Continued diversification of defense partnerships, as seen with India, should be pursued to enhance military capabilities and reduce over-reliance on any single external power. Finally, public communication campaigns regarding the new military conscription law will be vital to ensure smooth implementation and public understanding.
