Security Analysis Report: Cambodia (May 21-28, 2026)

Executive Summary

Cambodia's security landscape during May 21-28, 2026, was primarily shaped by significant internal efforts to combat cybercrime and external diplomatic maneuvers concerning border disputes. Prime Minister Hun Manet initiated a nationwide crackdown on cyber scam networks, addressing concerns about official complicity and national image. Concurrently, Cambodia enacted a mandatory military conscription law, a direct response to persistent border tensions with Thailand, particularly over a contested maritime area in the Gulf of Thailand. While engaging in UN-backed conciliation for the maritime dispute, Phnom Penh also continued to strengthen its strategic partnership with China, upgrading their security dialogue, and simultaneously resumed joint military exercises with the United States, showcasing a complex balancing act in its foreign policy.

Key Security Developments

- Cybercrime Crackdown and Official Complicity

On May 25, 2026, Prime Minister Hun Manet ordered a nationwide crackdown on telecom and online fraud, specifically targeting cyber scam networks and warning that provincial officials, district chiefs, village chiefs, police, and military police suspected of protecting these operations would face investigation and punishment. The Prime Minister emphasized that the government had received reliable intelligence regarding official complicity, stating that failure to act could create a "major disaster" and threaten national security. This move follows a cabinet meeting on May 22 where Hun Manet highlighted that telecom fraud damages public security, Cambodia's national image, and international reputation.

- Strengthening Cybersecurity Resilience in the Financial Sector

On May 20, 2026, Cybersecurity Day 2026 was held in Phnom Penh, focusing on "Strengthening Cybersecurity Resilience in Cambodia's Banking and Financial Sector." Organized by the Association of Banks in Cambodia (ABC), the event brought together over 500 participants from public institutions, regulators, law enforcement, and

financial institutions to discuss evolving cyber threats, regulatory frameworks, and best practices for data protection. This initiative underscores the growing priority of cybersecurity as the financial sector becomes increasingly digital and interconnected, aiming to protect users and institutions from system disruption, cyberattacks, fraud, and data breaches.

- Implementation of Mandatory Military Conscription

Cambodia's new conscription law officially came into effect on May 25, 2026, having been signed into law on May 23 by Senate President Hun Sen, acting as head of state. This legislation mandates two years of military service for Cambodian men aged 18 to 25, with penalties for evasion ranging from six months to five years in prison and fines. Prime Minister Hun Manet had announced in July 2025 that the law would be implemented in 2026, citing rising border tensions with Thailand as a key reason for activating the long-dormant statute. The law aims to reinforce the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces' capacity, promote national unity, and ensure preparedness against threats to territorial integrity.

- Persistent Maritime Dispute with Thailand over Energy Resources

The long-standing maritime dispute with Thailand over an estimated 27,000 square kilometers in the Gulf of Thailand, believed to hold US\$300 billion worth of natural gas and oil, gained renewed urgency. On May 27, 2026, Cambodia's Minister of Mines and Energy, Keo Rottanak, stated that the global fuel crisis, exacerbated by the Iran conflict, highlighted the critical need to resolve this dispute to unlock these resources. Thailand unilaterally terminated a 25-year-old agreement for joint offshore energy exploration earlier in May, prompting Cambodia to pursue compulsory conciliation under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS).

- Diplomatic Engagement on Border Issues with Thailand at the UN

Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Prak Sokhonn met with his Thai counterpart, Sihasak Phuangketkeow, on May 27, 2026, on the sidelines of the UN Security Council High-Level Open Debate in New York. While both ministers discussed the border situation, no agreement was reached on a future framework for negotiations, with Thailand having recently canceled a 2001 Memorandum of Understanding (MoU 44) on overlapping maritime claims. Sokhonn reiterated Cambodia's position on initiating compulsory conciliation under UNCLOS and called for the full implementation of the December 27, 2025, Joint Statement, which established a ceasefire after armed conflict.

- Cambodia's Stance on Territorial Integrity at ASEAN and UN

On May 21, 2026, General Vong Pon, Commander-in-Chief of the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces, reaffirmed at the 23rd ASEAN Chiefs of Defense Forces meeting that national borders must never be altered through force. He urged ASEAN members to strengthen cooperation in maintaining regional stability and thanked ASEAN states for

supporting ceasefire efforts along the frontier with Thailand. Separately, Cambodia's UN envoy, Keo Chhea, during a UN Security Council debate on May 21, 2026, emphasized the importance of protecting civilians in armed conflicts and respecting international humanitarian law, citing the displacement of over 649,000 civilians and damage to the Preah Vihear temple during conflicts in 2025.

- Deepening Strategic Partnership with China

On May 27, 2026, Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi and Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Prak Sokhonn met in New York, agreeing to further advance bilateral relations. They reaffirmed their strong commitment to deepening the Cambodia-China Comprehensive Strategic Partnership of Cooperation. A key development is the agreement to upgrade the "2+2" strategic dialogue mechanism (involving foreign and defense ministers) to a "3+3" mechanism, which will now also include public security authorities from both countries. This upgrade, initially agreed upon in April 2026, aims to strengthen law enforcement and defense cooperation, jointly combat online gambling and telecom fraud, and safeguard cybersecurity.

- Resumption of Joint Military Exercises with the United States

Following an eight-year suspension, discussions to revive the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercises between the Royal Cambodian Army and US Army Pacific were held in April 2026. This follows an agreement in November 2025 to renew these flagship drills, marking a restoration of defense cooperation that was halted in 2017 as Cambodia deepened ties with China. The exercises are designed to enhance interoperability and operational capabilities, reflecting a positive momentum in Cambodia-US bilateral relations, which also saw an increase in US government and congressional delegations, including from the Department of Defense, and port calls by US Navy ships.

- Bilateral Relations with Vietnam and the Czech Republic

On May 21, 2026, Vietnamese Minister of Foreign Affairs Le Hoai Trung hosted a reception for the newly-appointed Cambodian Ambassador to Vietnam, Touch Sopharath, reaffirming Vietnam's commitment to solidarity and friendship with Cambodia. Separately, on May 27, 2026, Cambodian Foreign Minister Prak Sokhonn briefed Czech Minister of Foreign Affairs Petr Macinka on the Cambodia-Thailand border issue during his visit to New York, expressing Cambodia's commitment to strengthening bilateral relations and cooperation with the Czech Republic.

Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Cambodia's recent security developments underscore a complex and evolving geopolitical strategy, balancing its historically strong ties with China against renewed

engagement with the United States, all while navigating persistent regional disputes. The upgrade of the Cambodia-China strategic dialogue to a "3+3" mechanism, including public security authorities, signals a deepening of their comprehensive strategic partnership, particularly in law enforcement, defense, and cybersecurity. This move reinforces China's influence in Cambodia and the broader Southeast Asian region, potentially impacting the regional balance of power. China's support for resolving regional disputes through dialogue and negotiation, as highlighted by Foreign Minister Wang Yi regarding the Cambodia-Thailand border, positions Beijing as a key diplomatic player.

Simultaneously, the resumption of the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercises with the United States, after an eight-year hiatus, indicates Cambodia's efforts to diversify its defense partnerships and avoid over-reliance on a single major power. This re-engagement with the US, which also includes increased visits by US defense delegations and Navy ships, suggests a pragmatic approach to foreign policy, seeking benefits from both global powers. This balancing act is crucial for Cambodia as it seeks to maintain its sovereignty and pursue national interests amidst growing geopolitical rivalry between the US and China in the Indo-Pacific.

The ongoing maritime dispute with Thailand, exacerbated by Thailand's unilateral termination of a joint exploration agreement and Cambodia's pursuit of UNCLOS conciliation, remains a significant regional flashpoint. The dispute, which has previously led to armed clashes and displacement, highlights the fragility of border stability in Southeast Asia. Cambodia's emphasis on peaceful dispute settlement and adherence to international law at the UN Security Council and ASEAN forums reflects its strategy to garner international support and legitimize its claims. The regional implications extend to ASEAN's role in mediating such disputes and the broader principle of territorial integrity in the face of resource competition.

Military and Defense Analysis

The implementation of mandatory military conscription, effective May 25, 2026, marks a significant shift in Cambodia's defense policy, aiming to bolster its force posture and personnel reserves. This move, requiring two years of service for men aged 18-25, is a direct response to perceived security challenges, particularly the persistent border tensions with Thailand. Prime Minister Hun Manet has also pledged to increase the national defense budget, indicating a commitment to modernizing the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces (RCAF) and enhancing its capabilities.

The resumption of the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercises with the United States, after an eight-year suspension, is a crucial development for Cambodia's military modernization programs. These exercises offer opportunities for the RCAF to

strengthen technical expertise, improve interoperability, and gain experience through collaboration with the US Army Pacific. This renewed defense cooperation with the US, alongside ongoing military engagement with China, allows Cambodia to access diverse training and equipment, potentially leading to a more versatile and capable defense force.

While specific defense acquisitions and arms deals within this reporting period were not detailed, the deepening security dialogue with China, now upgraded to a "3+3" mechanism, suggests continued and potentially expanded defense cooperation, including in areas of law enforcement and cybersecurity. This dual-track approach to defense partnerships reflects Cambodia's strategic autonomy, seeking to leverage assistance from both major powers to build a robust defense capacity primarily for territorial protection, as articulated by Prime Minister Hun Manet.

Outlook and Forecast

Short-term trends (1-3 months): In the immediate future, Cambodia is likely to intensify its internal crackdown on cyber scam operations, with increased arrests and investigations into corrupt officials. The implementation of the mandatory military conscription law will begin, leading to initial recruitment drives and public awareness campaigns. Diplomatic efforts concerning the maritime dispute with Thailand will continue, with Cambodia likely to formally initiate the compulsory conciliation process under UNCLOS. Bilateral engagements with both China and the United States will proceed, with further details emerging on the scope of the "3+3" dialogue and the "Angkor Sentinel" exercises.

Critical flashpoints and risk areas: The Cambodia-Thailand border, both land and maritime, remains a critical flashpoint. The unresolved maritime boundary dispute and Thailand's unilateral termination of the MoU could escalate tensions, particularly if energy exploration proceeds in contested areas without agreement. The Emerald Triangle area, where past clashes occurred, warrants close monitoring. Internally, the crackdown on cyber scams could lead to resistance from entrenched criminal networks and potentially expose deeper layers of corruption, posing internal security challenges. The forced labor aspect of these scams also presents ongoing human rights concerns.

Indicators to monitor: Key indicators to monitor include the progress and outcomes of the UNCLOS compulsory conciliation process with Thailand, which will significantly impact maritime stability and resource access. The effectiveness and reach of the cybercrime crackdown, including the prosecution of high-level officials, will be crucial for Cambodia's national image and internal security. The nature and frequency of joint military exercises with both the US and China, along with any new defense

acquisitions, will signal the trajectory of Cambodia's defense posture and its geopolitical alignment. Furthermore, any public reactions or challenges to the new conscription law should be observed.

Strategic recommendations: Cambodia should continue to prioritize diplomatic engagement with Thailand to de-escalate tensions and find a peaceful resolution to the maritime dispute, leveraging international legal frameworks like UNCLOS. Internally, sustaining the momentum of the cybercrime crackdown, coupled with judicial reforms to ensure transparency and accountability, is vital for long-term security and economic stability. From a defense perspective, Cambodia should strategically diversify its military partnerships, drawing on the strengths of both the US and China to enhance its capabilities while maintaining a non-aligned foreign policy stance. Investing in border surveillance and intelligence sharing with neighboring countries could also help mitigate risks in disputed areas.
