# Security Analysis Report: Cambodia (May 23, 2026 - May 30, 2026)

## Executive Summary

Cambodia's security landscape during the last week of May 2026 was dominated by heightened border tensions with Thailand, significant advancements in its defense posture, and a continued crackdown on cybercrime. The promulgation of a new military conscription law on May 23, 2026, underscores a strategic shift towards strengthening national defense capabilities amid ongoing regional instability. Concurrently, Cambodia deepened its military and diplomatic ties with China through preparations for the "Golden Dragon 2026" exercise, while also maintaining engagement with the United States and ASEAN on regional security matters. The government intensified its efforts against online scam operations, with Prime Minister Hun Manet issuing a stern warning to officials protecting these networks, reflecting a commitment to improving national image and security.

## Key Security Developments

- Military Conscription Law Enacted

Acting Head of State Hun Sen officially promulgated a new military conscription law on May 23, 2026, requiring Cambodian men aged 18 to 25 to serve 24 months in the military. This legislation, which replaces an older, unenforced 2006 law, aims to bolster national defense, instill patriotism, and build a robust reserve force. Training for the first cohort of conscripts is slated to commence by the end of 2026, with selection based on operational needs and applying equally to all citizens. The move is largely seen as a direct response to rising tensions with neighboring Thailand, which escalated into a "severe armed conflict" in mid-2025.

- Intensified Cambodia-Thailand Border Tensions

The border region with Thailand remained highly volatile, characterized by a heavily reinforced military presence from both nations. On May 30, 2026, the Royal Thai Navy launched 24-hour livestreams from three checkpoints in Chanthaburi and Trat provinces to counter social media rumors of illegal smuggling, highlighting the ongoing strict lockdown of eastern checkpoints due to the severe border crisis that

erupted in mid-2025. Thai Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul reiterated Thailand's firm stance on sovereignty on May 27, 2026, dismissing colonial-era maps as irrelevant for Bangkok.

- Diplomatic Engagements on Border Dispute at UNSC

Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation Prak Sokhonn addressed the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) on May 26, 2026. He emphasized the importance of peaceful dispute resolution, respect for international law, and expressed concern over "occupied areas of Cambodian territory," urging the full and urgent implementation of the Joint Statement of December 27, 2025. This followed a warning from Thai representative Sihasak on May 23, 2026, against Cambodia raising bilateral disputes at the UNSC.

- Golden Dragon 2026 Military Exercise Preparations with China

Cambodia and China are preparing for the "Golden Dragon 2026" joint military exercise, with senior commanders from both nations meeting on May 28, 2026, to discuss expanded drills. The exercise, which focuses on counter-terrorism, humanitarian relief, and disaster response, will involve modern equipment and multi-service operations, including naval and air forces. Operations have expanded to coastal waters and airspace off Preah Sihanouk Province, particularly at the Chinese-funded Ream Naval Base.

- High-Level Diplomatic Meetings with China

On May 27, 2026, Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister Prak Sokhonn held a bilateral meeting with Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi. Both reaffirmed their commitment to deepening the Cambodia-China Comprehensive Strategic Partnership of Cooperation and discussed regional stability, including the latest developments concerning the Cambodia-Thailand border issues. Additionally, Cambodia sought a strategic partnership with China in poverty reduction at the Global Poverty Reduction and Development Forum in Beijing from May 26-28, 2026.

- Crackdown on Cyber Scam Operations Intensifies

Prime Minister Hun Manet issued a nationwide directive on May 25, 2026, ordering local authorities, police, and military police to intensify efforts against telecom and online fraud. He warned that officials found protecting scam operations would face investigation and punishment, emphasizing that the government had received intelligence about such complicity. Senate President Hun Sen echoed this on May 24, 2026, stating that dismantling scam networks and their protective structures is crucial to prevent a "major disaster" and protect national security.

- New Anti-Technology Fraud Law in Force

Following its unanimous approval by parliament on March 30, 2026, and subsequent signing into law, Cambodia's new Law on Anti-Technology Fraud is now in effect. This

legislation introduces severe penalties, including up to life imprisonment for directing cyber scam operations, with harsher sentences for cases involving human trafficking, illegal confinement, or violence. The government aims to shut down all notorious online scam centers by the end of April 2026.

- Maritime Security Cooperation and Disputes

Cambodia reiterated its call for a rules-based maritime order at a UN Security Council debate on April 30, 2026, advocating for peaceful dispute resolution and enhanced maritime cooperation. The country reaffirmed its commitment to transparency and welcomed foreign vessels to the modernized Ream Naval Base for joint exercises and humanitarian efforts. Meanwhile, Thailand is moving to revoke a 2001 maritime agreement with Cambodia, citing a lack of progress and rising tensions over overlapping sea claims.

- Expulsion Order for African Nationals

Cambodia issued a directive on May 28, 2026, ordering all African nationals to leave the country by May 31, 2026, or face arrest and prosecution. This decision comes amid growing international concerns over transnational crime networks, including cybercrime and human trafficking, operating in the region. Human rights groups have expressed concern, noting that many affected individuals may be victims of trafficking.

- India-Cambodia Military Exercise Concludes

The second India-Cambodia bilateral military exercise, CINBAX-II 2026, concluded on May 17, 2026, in Kampong Speu Province, Cambodia. The 14-day exercise, which ran from May 4-17, involved 280 personnel focusing on "sub-conventional operations" and UN-mandated counter-terrorism drills, enhancing tactical synergy and showcasing modern technology like drone operations.

## Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Cambodia's security developments during this period significantly impact regional stability and its relations with major powers. The ongoing border conflict with Thailand remains a critical flashpoint, with both nations maintaining a strong military presence and engaging in diplomatic exchanges at the UN. The US, through its praise for Malaysia's ASEAN observer mission, is actively supporting de-escalation efforts, indicating a desire to prevent wider regional instability. This situation highlights the enduring challenges of colonial-era boundary demarcations and the potential for localized conflicts to draw in regional and international actors.

The deepening Cambodia-China strategic partnership, particularly through expanded military exercises like "Golden Dragon 2026" and high-level diplomatic meetings,

reinforces China's growing influence in Southeast Asia. The use of the Chinese-funded Ream Naval Base for these exercises further solidifies Beijing's strategic footprint in the Gulf of Thailand, a development closely watched by other regional powers and the United States. This strong alignment with China provides Cambodia with significant defense and economic support, as evidenced by discussions on poverty reduction.

Simultaneously, Cambodia is pursuing a balancing act with the United States, seeking to deepen bilateral cooperation in security and trade. The US lifting its arms sales ban in early 2025 and the resumption of joint military drills like "Angkor Sentinel" signal a strategic realignment by Phnom Penh. Cambodia's participation in President Trump's "Board of Peace" and its removal from the US Country Group D:5 for arms-embargoed countries further illustrate this shift, driven in part by the perceived lack of Chinese military support during the 2025 border conflict with Thailand and a desire to shed the "Scambodia" stigma to avoid US financial sanctions. This dual engagement strategy allows Cambodia to leverage support from both major powers while navigating complex regional dynamics.

## Military and Defense Analysis

Cambodia's military and defense posture is undergoing a significant transformation, primarily driven by the enactment of compulsory military service and a stated intent to increase defense spending for modernization. The new conscription law, requiring 24 months of service for men aged 18-25, is a foundational step towards building a larger and more capable reserve force, directly addressing perceived defense capacity limitations exposed during the 2025 border conflict with Thailand. This move aims to enhance both the quantity and quality of trained personnel, fostering patriotism and national unity.

The Royal Cambodian Armed Forces (RCAF) are actively engaged in strengthening capabilities through international cooperation. The upcoming "Golden Dragon 2026" exercise with China is set to be larger and more modern, incorporating multi-service operations, including ground, naval, and air forces, and utilizing advanced equipment. The expansion of these drills, particularly at the Ream Naval Base, indicates a focus on improving interoperability with Chinese forces and enhancing capabilities in areas like counter-terrorism and humanitarian relief. Concurrently, the resumption of the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercise with the United States, after an eight-year hiatus, signifies a renewed effort to improve technical expertise and operational readiness through collaboration with the US Army Pacific. The recent conclusion of the CINBAX-II 2026 exercise with India further diversifies Cambodia's military training partnerships, focusing on counter-terrorism and sub-conventional operations. These varied engagements reflect Cambodia's strategy to modernize its forces and enhance its defense capabilities through diverse international partnerships.

## Outlook and Forecast

Short-term trends (1-3 months): In the immediate future, Cambodia will likely continue to navigate the delicate balance of its foreign relations, particularly with Thailand, China, and the United States. The Cambodia-Thailand border will remain a focal point of tension, with continued military vigilance and diplomatic exchanges at international forums. The 24-hour livestreams initiated by Thailand suggest a sustained, high-alert environment. Internally, the government's crackdown on cyber scam operations is expected to intensify, with Prime Minister Hun Manet's strong warnings to complicit officials indicating a serious commitment to dismantling these networks and improving Cambodia's international reputation. The implementation phase of the military conscription law will begin to take shape, with initial preparations for training the first batch of recruits by year-end.

Critical flashpoints and risk areas: The Cambodia-Thailand border dispute remains the most critical flashpoint. Any miscalculation or escalation of incidents along the heavily militarized frontier could quickly destabilize the shaky ceasefire. The ongoing diplomatic exchanges at the UNSC highlight the deep-seated nature of the territorial disagreements. Another risk area is the effectiveness of the cybercrime crackdown. If the government fails to dismantle the "protective structures" shielding scam networks, as warned by Hun Sen, it could undermine national security and international trust. The expulsion order for African nationals by May 31, 2026, also carries humanitarian and reputational risks, especially if many are indeed victims of human trafficking.

Indicators to monitor: Key indicators to monitor include the frequency and nature of incidents along the Cambodia-Thailand border, any further diplomatic statements or actions from either side regarding the territorial dispute, and the progress of the ASEAN observer mission. Domestically, the number of arrests and successful dismantling of cyber scam compounds, particularly involving corrupt officials, will indicate the effectiveness of the government's anti-fraud campaign. The initial phases of military conscription, including recruitment numbers and public reception, will be important for assessing the long-term impact on Cambodia's defense capabilities and social cohesion. Developments at the Ream Naval Base, including the scale and frequency of joint exercises with China and port calls by other nations, will signal shifts in Cambodia's geopolitical alignment.

Strategic recommendations: Cambodia should prioritize de-escalation and sustained dialogue with Thailand, leveraging ASEAN and international mediation efforts to solidify the existing ceasefire and work towards a long-term resolution of border disputes. Internally, a transparent and robust implementation of the anti-cybercrime law is crucial, coupled with international cooperation to address human trafficking

concerns related to online scams. The government should ensure that the military conscription program is implemented fairly and effectively, with adequate training and support for recruits, while also continuing to invest in military modernization. Diplomatically, Cambodia should continue its balancing act between China and the United States, seeking to diversify its security partnerships and avoid over-reliance on any single power, thereby enhancing its strategic autonomy and resilience.
